

Alta Marshal's Report
June 15 - July 13, 2006

June 17, 2006 2:49 pm the Alta deputy assisted the County Sheriffs with a vehicle fire in the vicinity of Tanners Flat in the mid-canyon.

June 20, 2006 The Marshal's Office did their part to help with the annual Little Cottonwood Canyon Cleanup Day.

June 21, 2006 The Alta deputy assisted the County Sheriffs with a reckless driving complaint. The deputy located the aggressive motorist and detained the driver for the Sheriffs deputy. The driver was cited for the driving violations and for having a dog in the watershed. 7:38 pm the deputy helped the UFA package-up a 22 year old patient who injured his ankle while hiking in Alta. He was transported from the Sunnyside parking area to a hospital in the valley by private vehicle.

June 23, 2006 4:46 pm The Alta deputy assisted the County Sheriffs with a vehicle rollover in the lower canyon. No injuries were reported.

June 24, 2006 8:52 pm The Marshals Office was involved with trying to help locate a reported missing person from the Snowbird resort. An hour later the presumed missing person was located at her work place in the Salt Lake Valley.

June 26, 2006 9:00 am The deputy on duty investigated and took a report from the owner of a vehicle that had a window broken out of his car while it was parked at the Hellgate condominiums. 5:50 pm the deputy was dispatched to the area of Watson Shelter, mid-mountain in the Alta Ski Area to find out why a motorist had driven his vehicle past signs and gates to reach that location. And the typical response was. "Oh I didn't see any signs or gates."

June 30, 2006 10:30 pm A large thunder storm which produced very heavy rain caused rock and mud slides in the canyon. The effects were serious enough that the canyon road had to be closed from 10:30 pm to 1:10 am in order to allow crews to clear the road of debris.

July 5, 2006 12:21 am, Salt Lake County Sheriffs Dispatch called to inform us of an intoxicated, suicidal subject that may be in our area. The person and his vehicle were located in Alta, at the Sunnyside parking area. Sheriff's deputies assisted the Alta deputy with the arrest and transportation of the subject to the University Hospital for evaluation. The subject was arrested for his forth DUI and the vehicle was impounded.

July 8, 2006 8:51 am The Hellgate Condominium management called to report that their housekeeping found a person in one of the rooms they were cleaning. The Marshal and deputy met with the man, interviewed and mitigated some confusing issues. The person was then given a ride by the deputy to a relative's home in the Salt Lake Valley. 5:37 pm a motorist drove off the road near the Cercret Lake parking area when she was distracted by a bee that flew in the window of her car. The cars front wheel was damaged and had to be towed downtown for service.

July 11, 2006 Another motorist was in need of a rescue when he backed his small truck off the road at the first switch-back on the Summer Road. With the help of the Town Public Works Department truck we were able to pull the vehicle back on the road.

July 12, 2006 The Marshal was dispatched to assist the County Sheriff's with a motorcycle wreck in the area of seven turns, mid-canyon.
