

Marshal's Report
March 8 - April 12, 2007

March 9, 2007 5:50 pm the Alta Deputy with assistance from a County deputy responded to a reported civil disturbance involving an intoxicated person at a residence on the By-Pass Road. 6:45 pm the Alta deputy responded to a fight in progress at the Iron Blossom Lodge at the Snowbird Resort.

March 10, 2007 2:58 pm the deputy was dispatched to the Alta Ski Lifts to investigate an incident involving an out of bounds skier.

March 11, 2007 The deputy met with a complainant regarding an incident that occurred March 6th in the Albion Basin. The person reported being chased and threatened by a German Sheppard dog. 1:48 pm a report of a skier released avalanche on Mount Superior was looked into by search and rescue volunteers to determine if anyone had been caught in the slide. Nobody was caught or injured.

March 12, 2007 8:18 am the deputy investigated a minor car crash in the Goldminer's parking lot. 6:19 pm the Hellgate, Superior section of town was closed and interlodged due to the wet slide avalanche activity. The restrictions were lifted at 10:00 pm.

March 13, 2007 10:00 am the Hellgate, Superior area was again closed due the wet slide activity and reopened at 8:00 pm. 2:51 pm an unusually large wet slide off Flagstaff mountain was cause to alarm the avalanche forecasters and public safety personnel into keeping a close eye on the avalanche paths above the town.

March 14, 2007 9:37 am the Alta deputy came across a snowboarder who apparently lost control of his ride and crashed onto the pavement on the By-Pass Road. Finding him unconscious, emergency medical personnel determined he had significantly rung his bell and transported him to the Snowbird Clinic. 12:00 noon the Hellgate, Superior area was closed due to the wet slide activity and reopened at 7:00 pm. 3:15 pm a wet slide avalanche off Emma Ridge, above the Town of Alta had emergency services on there toes once again, keeping an eye on skiers and hikers in the area. One outdoor enthusiast in particular was intercepted at the ridge line by one of our UDOT avalanche forecasters and brought off the mountain via a safe route.

March 15, 2007 1:00 pm the Hellgate, Superior section of town was closed and interlodged due to the avalanche hazard. The restrictions were lifted at 6:28 pm.

March 16, 2007 12:15 pm the restrictions were again in place for the Hellgate area and reopened at 8:00 pm. Due to the ongoing situation with the wet slide avalanche hazard the Town of Alta was temporarily closed and interlodged at 4:00 pm for avalanche mitigation. The mission was carried out with the use of hand charges dropped from the helicopter. The restrictions were lifted at 4:41 pm.

March 17, 2007 11:30 am the Hellgate, Superior section of town was closed due to the avalanche hazard and reopened at 7:43 pm. 3:23 pm a driver of a vehicle was stopped and arrested at the mouth of the canyon after being involved in a multiple hit and run incident that occurred in the Lower Albion parking lot. 4:00 pm the Town of Alta was again temporarily closed and interlodged for avalanche control. The restrictions were lifted around 5:00 pm.

March 18, 2007 12:00 noon the Hellgate, Superior area was again closed and interlodged due the avalanche hazard. The area was reopened at 6:52 pm. 7:32 pm the Marshal's and UFA were dispatched to the Rustler Lodge on a medical emergency involving a two year old child who sustained minor burns from hot water.

March 24, 2007 4:28 pm the Alta deputy helped reunite a five year old child with his mother in the Lower Albion parking lot.

March 30, 2007 10:18 am the Alta Postal Clerk called to report she had received a package that had a very strong odor of marijuana. The Marshal's Office along with help from the US Postal Inspectors watched as the package was picked up by personnel from one of the local lodges and delivered to the person it was addressed to. The person accepted the package and was arrested for the controlled substance. 11:00 am the Hellgate, Superior section of town was temporarily closed for avalanche rescue training. 5:00 pm a person called in to report a lost driver's license. At 11:14 pm the Marshal's and UFA responded to a medical emergency at the Goldminer's Lodge involving a three year old child with flu symptoms.

March 31, 2007 12:34 am the Alta deputy assisted the County Sheriffs with a vehicle roll-over, mid-canyon, near seven turns. No injuries were reported. 3:42 pm the Marshal's and UFA were dispatched to the Alta Peruvian Lodge for a 30 year old woman who had fainted. 9:00 pm the Power Company was called to deal with power problems in the Town of Alta. Many business's and homes were without power throughout the night. 10:55 pm the Deputy was called to the Goldminer's Bar to assist management with four intoxicated patrons who refused to leave.

April 8, 2007 6:05 pm Alta Marshal's and UFA were dispatched to a residence on Martha road to help a 60 year old female with chest pains. The patient was transported to the hospital by ambulance.

April 10, 2007 3:25 pm The Alta deputy assisted the County Sheriffs with a car crash mid-canyon near Tanner's Flat. 4:30 pm the deputy was called to make contact with a group of skier/snowboarders who were trespassing on a house on the Albion Summer Road.
