

## **MARSHAL'S REPORT JULY14 THROUGH AUGUST 09, 2007**

- **July 14, 12:05 a.m. - The Deputy on Duty investigated a suspicious vehicle in the Flagstaff Parking Area. At 3:49 a.m., the deputy investigated a report of a domestic disturbance at a bypass road residence. At 9:05 a.m., a lost property report was taken. At 6:36 p.m. A summer road resident reported a vehicle with a hose running from its exhaust into the passenger compartment. The vehicle fled upon seeing our caller. The deputy stopped the vehicle and interviewed the two occupants who were in obvious emotional distress. The Fire Department responded and both occupants were transported to a local hospital for evaluation. At 9:47 p.m., the deputy was called to assist the County Sheriff with a fight at Snowbird.**
- **July 17, 8:01 a.m. The Deputy on Duty encountered a bicycle accident in the lower canyon. A 40 year old male was transported to the hospital with minor injuries.**
- **July 18, 4:45 p.m., the Marshal stopped a vehicle who's driver had been harassing bike riders on the canyon road. At 5:31 p.m., the Marshal assisted the Sheriff's and Fire Departments with a vehicle fire at Tanner's Flat.**

A 21 year old male was brought from the mountain by search and rescue crews after suffering substantial injuries in a fall. At 6:32 p.m., a 66 year old male was transported from one of the lodges to a hospital after losing consciousness.**
