

MARSHAL'S REPORT
July 10th through August 13, 2008

- **July 10th, 5:20 pm-** An alarm was investigated at a local business.
- **July 13th, 12:51 pm-** The deputy on duty assisted with a car fire near Snowbird entry #2. At 2:28 pm, assistance was given to a woman who had injured an ankle in Albion Basin.
- **July 21st, 7:28 pm-** A report was received of a reckless driver racing up the canyon. The deputy on duty intercepted the vehicle in Alta. A Murray man was charged with reckless driving and unregistered vehicle.
- **July 22nd, 1139 am-** An Alta resident received a warning notice for failing to maintain their dog under control in Albion Basin.
- **July 26th, 9:36 am-** A report was taken regarding damaged caused to a vehicle when an unsecured trailer rolled into it in the Cecret parking area.
- **July 28th, 9:00 pm-** The Marshal's Office assisted the County Sheriff and Unified Fire Authority with a serious traffic accident in the seven turns area of the canyon. A 53 year old driver lost control of their vehicle which rolled several hundred feet down the embankment. The driver was flown from the scene in critical condition. The highway was closed for several hours due to the severity of the accident.
- **July 31st, 10:00 pm-** The deputy on duty was called to quiet an unruly group in the Albion Basin campground.
- **Aug. 2nd, 1:03 pm-** The Marshal's and Fire departments responded to a woman with a leg injury on a hiking trail in Albion Basin. The patient was transported to a local hospital via ambulance.
- **Aug. 3rd, 9:52 am-** A report was taken of lost property on the Albion Summer road. At 11:17 am, the Marshal's and Fire departments responded to a shoulder injury in the "Gunsight" area. A male was assisted from the mountain and transported to a local hospital.
- **Aug. 10th, 12:25 pm-** A minor traffic accident was investigated near the information booth. One driver received a citation for improper backing. At 2:05 pm, a missing person report resulted in a multi-agency search for a 90 year old man overdue from a hike from Alta into American Fork Canyon. The male was located unharmed in Albion Basin.
