

**MARSHAL'S REPORT**  
**NOVEMBER 8<sup>TH</sup>-DECEMBER 12<sup>TH</sup>, 2007**

**November 15, 11:54 a.m.- A 27 year old man suffered head injuries in a fall from a ladder at a Bypass Road construction site. He was flown from the scene by a medical helicopter in serious condition.**

**November 16, 9:32 p.m.- A 60 year old male lost consciousness after a ground level fall outside the Peruvian Lodge. He was transported to a hospital via ambulance.**

**November 17, 8:40 p.m.- A male with chest pains was transported via ambulance from the Goldminer's Daughter Lodge.**

**November 18, 12:19 p.m.- A young male suffered a fractured femur in a fall in the Lower Albion Area and was transported to the hospital via ambulance.**

**At 2:55 p.m., the Deputy on Duty investigated the theft and fraudulent use of a credit card from a bypass residence.**

**November 19, 11:07 a.m.- A vehicle burglary was investigated in the Grizzly Gulch area.**

**November 24, 3:59 p.m.- A 53 year old male was transported from the mountain by the Alta Ski Patrol with possible spinal injuries following a pre-season ski accident in the Collin's area.**

**December 2, 2:49 p.m.- A report of a backcountry avalanche in the Flagstaff Area prompted a search and rescue mobilization. A hasty search determined that no one had been caught in the slide.**

**December 4, 7:00 a.m.- The Town of Alta and Lower canyon were placed on interlodge/outside travel restrictions for test firing of avalanche control weaponry.**

**December 7, 1:55 a.m.- A simple stuck vehicle call in the Wildcat Parking area turned out to be what is commonly referred to in police work as "J.D.L.R." (Just don't look right). The female driver was found in the company of a lodge guest anxious to help "his niece" from her predicament. The Deputy quickly established that there was in fact no family resemblance and that the young lady was in the employ of a downtown escort service. Citation and a tow truck; roughly \$300. Deer in the headlights looks all around; PRICELESS!**

**December 9, 2:19 a.m.-** A disoriented and quite possibly intoxicated man who's vocabulary consisted of the words "Park City" and "dos tequilas" was assisted from Alta in handcuffs and also benefited from the tow truck company's services.
