November 11th, 6:48 pm- An alarm was investigated at a bypass road residence.

November 13th, 11:36 am- A skier triggered avalanche prompted a rescue in the "Gunsight" area. A male patient sustained serious injuries and was transported to a local hospital via ambulance.

November 15th, 8:00 am- The highway was briefly restricted for testing of avalanche control devices.

November 18th, 3:35 am- Another alarm was investigated at a home on the bypass road.

November 27th, 8:00 am- A report was taken regarding items taken from a parked vehicle.

December 1st-6th- The Marshals Office assisted with several vehicles that had slid off the roadway in the lower canyon. It is not uncommon for icy conditions to exist in parts of the lower canyon that do not receive much sunlight this time of year. Remember to slow down and be careful!
