

Town Marshal's Report; November 11th – December 8th, 2010

Misc duties:

- 66 property/business/ski rack checks
- 15 motorist assist calls
- 7 traffic violations
- 12 alcohol enforcements
- 5 outside agency assists

- 2 alarm responses

November 18th, 7:00 am- The Town of Alta was placed on Interlodge Closure until 9:25 am for test firing of avalanche control weapons. At 1:53 pm, the deputy on duty handled a trespassing complaint involving a group of juveniles skiing/jumping from the roof of a business.

November 19th, 6:45 am- The Town of Alta was placed on Interlodge Closure again to complete sighting in of avalanche control weapons.

November 20th, 9:20 am- A search by the Marshal's Office and Alta Ski Patrol was initiated after a man failed to show up at work and could not be located in his room at one of the local lodges. After a dog search of the snow surrounding the lodge and parking areas, contacting all businesses in town, and a sweep of the entire highway, the man was located downtown with a friend following a night of bar-hopping. Very glad you are safe sir but, next time please call someone...

November 23rd, 8:00 pm- The Hellgate/Superior section of the highway was closed and placed on Interlodge overnight due to avalanche concerns.

November 24th, 1:49 am- A response was made to one of the lodges regarding a man who claimed to have been threatened at another lodge where he was employed. Upon arrival, it was evident that mental health issues existed. The person was provided shelter for the night and departed Alta the following day.

November 25th, 10:32 am- The Marshal's Office assisted the Unified Police and Fire Departments with a rollover accident in the Tanner's Flat area. Fortunately the occupant of the vehicle only sustained minor injuries.

November 26th, 8:30 am- A search for a missing Alta man ended when it was discovered that he had been involved in a serious traffic accident lower in the canyon. The man was flown from the scene by medical helicopter to a local hospital.

November 28th, 8:00 pm- The Hellgate/Superior area was again closed overnight due to increasing avalanche hazard.

December 4th, 9:00 am- An enhanced patrol operation conducted by U.S. Forest Service Law Enforcement and assisted by the Marshal's Office, and Unified Police Department was conducted in the canyon. Enforcements related to controlled substances, alcohol violations, and traffic safety were made.
