

Marshal's Report
January 11th -February 8th

January 12, 2007 7:00 pm The deputy on duty investigated a minor car crash in the Flagstaff parking area.

January 13, 2007 2:39 pm Dispatch received a complaint of snowmobiles that came over the ridge in the Catherine's Pass area. The complaint was referred to the County Sheriffs Office and the Forest Service. 4:05 pm the Marshals and UFA were dispatched to the Rustler Lodge when a 19 year old kitchen employee passed out.

January 15, 2007 9:45 am The Marshal investigated a car vs. UTA bus crash in the Lower Albion Parking Lot. 3:41 pm A hit and run vehicle crash report was taken that occurred in the Peruvian Lodge parking lot. 4:54 pm a report of a pair of stolen Scarpa T Race ski boots was taken. The theft occurred off the boot dryer at the Motherload Ski Shop.

January 18, 2007 8:25 am the Alta deputy responded to a complaint at the Peruvian Lodge. An employee that was partying the previous night didn't make it to his bed and was found passed out in the conference room. The person reluctantly was removed from the area prior to a group meeting.

January 19, 2007 8:03 am the deputy took a report of a hit and run car crash in the lower Albion Parking lot.

January 20, 2007 4:59 pm the deputy investigated a car vs. UTA bus in the Goldminers parking lot.

January 21, 2007 1:57 am an Albion Basin cabin owner called to report his snowmobile was run over and damaged by another cabin owners snowcat.

January 22, 2007 6:17 pm the Marshal's Office initiated a search for a reported missing person. The 19 year old female employee of a local business returned back home about an hour later, thus terminating the search. 9:45 pm the deputy assisted with a medical emergency at the Snowbird Resort.

January 28, 2007 3:58 pm called to report a local employee that was involved in a skier collision. The employee was issued a citation for theft of services for skiing without a ski pass.

January 30, 2007 5:50 pm the Marshal's Office received a complaint regarding dog poop not being cleaned up by dog owners. An email was sent out around the community in regards to this issue. We have received many helpful responses as to who may be responsible for violating the ordinances.

February 2, 2007 7:58 am Alta Marshal's and UFA were dispatched to the Albion Grill to help locate a strange burning smell. A piece of melting plastic was located in a heater.

February 3, 2007 1:00 am the deputy responded to the Snowbird Tram Club to assist the Salt Lake County Sheriffs with a fight. Apparently the intoxicated aggressor did not like people from the state of Wisconsin. 8:19 am the Alta deputy assisted with a vehicle roll-over in the White Pine area. 8:53 am a person called dispatch to report a lost wallet. 10:16 am. Alta Central Dispatch and the deputy assisted with a Wasatch Backcountry Rescue call out for two snowshoers that were caught in an avalanche on the south facing side of the Pfeifferhorn peak in Utah County. It took several hours for rescuers to reach the victims due to the location of the accident. The injured victims were eventually flown to the hospital by medical helicopter.

February 4, 2007 7:05 pm the Alta deputy and UFA were dispatched to a home on the By-Pass Road to treat and access a 39 year old person with altitude sickness.
