

MARSHAL'S REPORT
JUNE 12TH through July 9th, 2008

- **Roadway maintenance and dust control has been scheduled for the Albion Summer Road. Dust control is scheduled for July 18th. The compound used usually takes 24 hours to dry. The road should be open to the public after this occurs.**

- **June 12th, 10:18 pm- A suspicious vehicle was investigated in the Flagstaff Parking Area.**

- **June 13th, 8:52 pm- The deputy on duty checked on the welfare of an Albion Basin resident who had not been seen for a few days. All was found to be fine.**

- **June 21st, 9:25 pm- A car vs. deer accident was investigated in the Hellgate area.**

- **June 23rd, 6:07 pm- Contact was made with a suspicious group of people in the Flagstaff area. A male with outstanding warrants was arrested and transported to the Salt Lake County jail.**

- **June 24th, 8:00 am- The Marshal's Office and Sheriff's Department provided traffic control for the annual Little Cottonwood Clean-up.**

- **June 28th, 1:29 pm- The deputy on duty assisted Sheriff's deputies with a traffic stop. Information had been received that an occupant of the vehicle was wanted for arrest warrants. Quantities of controlled substances were located in the vehicle. The male was arrested and transported to jail.**

- **June 30th, 5:03 am- The Marshal's Office and Unified Fire Authority responded to a fire alarm at a Bypass Road residence. The alarm was found to be false.
