

**MARSHAL'S REPORT
MAY 11-JUNE 20, 2007**

May 12, 12:10 a.m.; The Deputy on Duty responded to assist the Sheriff's and Fire Departments with a car versus motorcycle accident near Snowbird Entry 3. The rider was treated for possible neck injuries.
