

**Marshal's Report**  
**February 8 - March 8, 2007**

February 8, 2007      8:16 pm The Alta deputy assisted Salt Lake County Sheriffs with a male subject that was causing problems in the cliff spa at the Snowbird resort.

February 10, 2007      1:06 pm The deputy took a report from a motorist that crashed into a rock on the roadway east of the Forest Service garage. The vehicle received substantial damage and was towed to the valley.

February 11, 2007      6:30 am the By-Pass Road was temporarily closed for avalanche control in the Blackjack area of Snowbird. 4:21 pm the Hellgate, Superior section of the Town of Alta was closed and interlodged due to the increasing avalanche hazard.

February 12, 2007      6:15 am all of Little Cottonwood Canyon and the Town of Alta were closed and interlodged for avalanche control over the highway. The restrictions were lifted at 7:45 am.

February 13, 2007      12:24 am the Alta deputy with assistance from the County Sheriffs responded to a civil altercation at the Goldminers Daughter Lodge involving three employees. The Police Officers mitigated the disturbance and left the scene, only to be called back a short time later when the argument resumed. This time measures were taken to remove one of the subjects from the lodge. In the morning all parties involved were terminated from their employment. 5:48 pm the deputy investigated a hit and run car crash in the lower Albion parking lot. 8:17 pm a person called in a complaint regarding a driver that was driving crazy in the Albion parking lot and had hit a piece of Alta Ski Lift's equipment. The driver was located in the apartment of the Albion Day Lodge and issued a citation for leaving the scene of an accident.

February 15, 2007      7:39 pm The Marshal and his deputy investigated an illegal display of fireworks at the Alta Ski Lift's, Buckhorn building. An agreement was made between the Marshal and the residents of the building.

February 16, 2007      7:00 am the By-Pass Road was temporarily restricted for avalanche control. 8:40 am the Hellgate, Superior section of town was closed and interlodged due to the increasing avalanche hazard.

February 17, 2007      7:20 am helicopter bombing was done in the Hellgate, Superior section to reduce the avalanche hazard.

February 18, 2007      7:00 pm the Alta deputy investigated a hit and run car crash that was witnessed at the Chalet Day John residence.

February 19 2007      10:28 am the deputy investigated accident involving a snowcat and a parked snowmobile in the Grizzly Gulch area.

February 23, 2007 3:00 pm the Hellgate, Superior section of town was closed interlodged due to the avalanche hazard.

February 24, 2007 6:00 am all of Little Cottonwood Canyon and the Town of Alta were closed and interlodge restriction was put into effect for avalanche control work. The restrictions were lifted at 7:48 am. 11:35 am the Marshal's Office assisted with traffic control at the top of the By-Pass Road when parking in the Town of Alta filled to capacity.

February 25, 2007 5:37 am an accident report was investigated involving a state plow vs. a parked vehicle's bumper.

February 26, 2007 6:30 am the Town of Alta was closed and interlodged for avalanche control. The restrictions were lifted at 7:42 am. At 8:47 am the Marshal's and UFA were dispatched to the Rustler Lodge to aid a 12 year old girl who had hit her head and was not feeling well. She was transported to the Alta Clinic. 12:10 pm a 60 year old man was transported to the hospital by medical helicopter after suffering a heart attack at the Watson's restaurant. And at 7:40 pm a man called to report that he had lost his wallet while skiing at the Alta Resort.

February 27, 2007 10:00 am the Hellgate, Superior section of town was closed and interlodged. At 11:37 am the By-Pass Road was temporarily restricted for avalanche control. And at 1:00 pm the lower canyon below Snowbird's entry one was temporarily closed for avalanche control mid-canyon. The road was reopened at 1:47 pm.

February 28, 2007 6:30 am Little Cottonwood Canyon and the Town of Alta were closed and interlodged for avalanche control. The restrictions were lifted at 7:27 am.

March 1, 2007 4:00 pm a man called dispatch to report a lost wallet.

March 2, 2007 6:15 am Little Cottonwood Canyon and the Town of Alta were closed and interlodged for avalanche control. The restrictions were lifted at 8:35am

March 3, 2007 11:00 am the Marshal's Office assisted with traffic control at the top of the By-Pass Road when parking in the town filled to capacity.

March 4, 2007 5:22 pm a person called to report a lost cell phone.

March 5, 2007 1:20 am the Alta deputy assisted the County Sheriffs with a vandalism incident that occurred in the Cliff Lodge at Snowbird. The suspects were tracked to the Rustler Lodge were one of the two suspects was arrested and transported to the County Jail. All vehicles parked on State Road 210 in the Town of Alta were relocated for North Side Plowing.

March 6, 2007 4:42 pm the Alta deputy assisted UFA with a medical emergency at the Iron Blossom Lodge at the Snowbird Resort.
