

MARSHAL'S REPORT
February 13th through March 11, 2008

- **February 15th 3:14 p.m.-** The Deputy on Duty was called to investigate an accident in the mid-canyon. A Sheriff's Office vehicle parked alongside the highway was struck by a motorist traveling down canyon. There were no injuries and the motorist was cited for negligent collision.
- **February 16th 11:37 a.m.-** The Marshal's and Fire Departments responded to the Hellgate Condominiums for a man who had fallen from the roof while clearing snow. The man was transported to a local hospital with possible fractures. At 4:37 p.m. a report was taken regarding a skier collision.
- **February 17th 6:00 p.m.-** A disoriented and possibly injured skier was found walking from the mountain. Skier was transported to a local hospital via ambulance.
- **February 18th 3:22 a.m.-** A medical response was made to the Alta Peruvian Lodge for a person with chest pain. The patient was transported to a hospital via ambulance. At 4:00 p.m., a minor traffic accident was investigated in the lower Albion parking area.
- **February 19th 10:57 p.m.-** A 22 year old male was injured in a sledding accident in the Corkscrew area. The Alta Ski Patrol and Unified Fire Authority crews assisted the man from the mountain. He was transported to a local hospital with a possible broken femur.
- **February 21st 4:28 p.m.-** A hit and run accident was investigated in the Flagstaff parking area. At 6:00 p.m., the Fire Department responded to one of the lodges for a person with difficulty breathing.
- **February 23rd 6:53 a.m.-** A report was received of a parked vehicle with a broken out window. The owner was contacted and it was determined that nothing had been taken from the vehicle.
- **February 24th 6:00 p.m.-** The Hellgate/Superior area was closed and interlodge travel restrictions were put into effect due to developing avalanche hazard. At 6:50 p.m., the Fire Department responded to a Bypass Road residence for a male with a cut hand.
- **February 25th 6:30 a.m.-** The canyon highway was closed and interlodge put into effect while avalanche control work was carried out. At 8:10 p.m., a traffic accident was investigated on the Bypass Road.
- **March 1st 9:16 p.m.-** A report was taken concerning a lost wallet.

- **March 2nd 1:49 a.m.-** The Hellgate/Superior area was placed on interlodge. At 6:30 a.m., the remainder of the canyon was closed and placed on interlodge for avalanche control work.
- **March 3rd 2:39 a.m.-** The Fire Department responded to the Peruvian Lodge for a man having breathing difficulties. He was transported to the hospital via ambulance.
- **March 4th 8:45 p.m.-** A suspicious male was reported hanging around the Goldminer's Daughter Lodge. The man was given a ride down the canyon to a local shelter. At 9:52 p.m., a bar fight was reported at one of the lodges. The parties involved were located and it was determined that the incident stemmed from a sports argument and that no serious physical contact had been made. No one involved wanted to press charges.
- **March 11th 6:28 a.m.-** The Unified Fire Authority responded to the Rustler Lodge to attend to a sick person.
