

MARSHAL'S REPORT
APRIL 10TH THROUGH May 7, 2008

- **Deputy Marshal Kevin Payne has successfully completed his police academy training and is now on board. Deputy Payne has previously worked for the Marshal's Office and we're excited to see him back.**
- **April 10th, 4:21 am- The Hellgate/Superior area and lower canyon were closed and interlodge travel restrictions were put into effect for avalanche control work.**
- **April 12th, 1:57 pm- The Hellgate/Superior area was again restricted until 6:00 pm due to warming weather creating avalanche activity. At 5:33 pm, a 25 year old man was charged with theft of services. He was caught skiing into a closed area at Snowbird from Alta. The man was using a stolen season ski pass.**
- **April 13th, 11:29 am- The Hellgate/Superior area was closed due to avalanche hazard. At 7:47 pm, Deputy Bolen confiscated two kegs of beer that had somehow found their way from a lodge bar to the Wildcat Parking lot. The lodge reclaimed their kegs and the festivities were moved back to the bar.**
- **April 14th, 12:01 am- A fifty five year old man called Alta Central dispatch to demand a ride home from the police. He explained that he was too drunk to get his key to open his car door. Upon arrival, the deputy found the intoxicated and quite ill man on the ground. After a quick check by the medics, the man was released to a friend and given a ride home.**
- **April 22nd, 2:30 am- A resident reported that his vehicle had been damaged, possibly by ski edges in the Grizzly parking area.**
- **April 26th, 9:35 am- A number of Alta Employees and residents called to report that a local woman had failed to show up at an annual after season gathering in southern Utah. Adding to the concern, the woman's cell phone had been found outside a business in the Town of Levan, along the route. Calls were placed to the Highway Patrol and Sheriff's Offices along the route. The woman eventually showed up at the gathering and the various attempts to locate her were cancelled.**

- **April 28th, 6:30 am-** The Hellgate/Superior area was closed to test fire on of the avalanche control weapons.
- **May 1st, 6:30 am-** The Hellgate/Superior area and lower canyon were closed while avalanche control work was carried out.
- **May 5th, 7:28 am-** A vandalism report was received after it was discovered two fire extinguishers has been emptied into the ski patrol locker room. Later in the evening, the Marshal's Office was called to assist the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office with a fatal vehicle accident in the Snowbird entry three area.
