April 9th, 5:00 pm- A 33 year old male with a broken arm and possible knee injury was rescued from Grizzly Gulch following a skiing accident.

April 10th, 11:45 am- The Marshal's Office assisted the Unified Police Department (UPD) with a juvenile problem at a resort West of Alta.

April 13th, 10:30-11:30 am- The mid-canyon area was closed for avalanche control work.

April 22nd, 12:26 pm- The Marshal's Office responded to a hold up alarm at the Alta Ski Area. The alarm was found to be false.

April 23rd, 8:03 am- The deputy on duty assisted UPD with a three car accident near Snowbird Entry 3.

April 25th, 3:37 pm- A medical response was made for a person who had sustained a possible head injury after falling in a town parking area.

April 27th, 11:12 am- An alert resident reported occupants of a vehicle using drugs in the Bypass Road area. UPD responded to assist. One male was arrested for possession of heroin and paraphernalia.

April 30th, 6:45 am- The Town of Alta was placed on Interlodge restrictions until 9:02 am for avalanche control work. At 11:20 am, a theft report was taken regarding a missing delivery item. At 12:20 pm, a minor traffic accident was investigated in the Powder Ridge area.

May 2nd, 6:30 am- Interlodge/Road closures occurred until 8:53 am for avalanche control.

May 3rd, 6:30 am- Interlodge/Road closures were again in place for avalanche control work.

May 8th, 7:28 pm- A 911 hang up call was received. Upon callback a person claimed to be staying at one of the lodges in a room number that didn't exist. The caller was eventually discovered to be an intoxicated bar patron and was released to a person who agreed to take responsibility for removing him from the canyon.
