October 19 - November 9, 2006

October 22, 2006 2:40 pm The Marshal's and UFA responded to the Rustler Lodge to aid a 32 year old male who had fainted and hit his head

October 25, 2006 2:52 pm The Marshal's and UFA were dispatched to a residence on Martha Road for a medical emergency. The Patient was transported to the hospital by ambulance.

October 27, 2006 4:44 pm Two motorists driving trucks up the Albion ski run were cited for off-roading in the watershed.

November 4, 2006 2:45 pm the Alta deputy assisted the manager of the Snowpine Lodge when he locked himself out of the lodge.

November 5, 2006 2:40 pm Alta Central received a call from 911 to inform us that UFA was responding to a victim with a possible broken femur in the area of Baldy Shoulder in the Collins Gulch. Alta Ski Patrol provided snowmobile transportation and assisted paramedics. The patient was transported to the hospital by Lifeflight helicopter.

November 8, 2006 4:45 pm Salt Lake County Sheriffs deputy informed us of a report from a cell phone caller that he was stuck on a cliff some where above Alta. As it turns out the 27 year old wayward hiker had arrived in Alta the day before and is employed at the Peruvian Lodge. At 5:25 he was located with binoculars on the edge of the cliff in Hellgate Bowl. 6:25 Lifeflight helicopter made a successful drop of warm clothes and some food. Two climbing teams from Salt Lake Search and Rescue headed off to the top of the mountain and roped down reaching the victim at 9:30. 10:30 the victim and the rescue teams were back in town safe and sound.
