

**MARSHAL'S REPORT**  
**October 12-November 7, 2007**

- **October 10<sup>th</sup> 5:53 PM-** A suspicious vehicle was investigated in the Albion Campground.
- **October 15<sup>th</sup> 8:32 PM-** A Search and Rescue Operation was conducted in the Hellgate Cliffs after two young men became stranded on a ledge after dark and called 911 by cell phone. The Marshal's Office, Sheriff's Office, Salt Lake County Search and Rescue, Unified Fire Authority, and a helicopter from the Utah Highway Patrol all responded and took part in rescue operations. The helicopter crew was able to locate the teens and drop warm clothing and lighting to them. Search and Rescue personnel were able to extract them from the cliff and assist them from the mountain safely.
- **October 16<sup>th</sup> 8:22 PM-** The Albion Summer road was closed for the season due to snowfall and preparations for the upcoming ski season.
- **October 19<sup>th</sup> 12:15 PM-** A citation was issued to a person for having a prohibited dog in the watershed in the Flagstaff parking area.
- **October 22<sup>nd</sup> 1:32 PM-** A 17 year old male with possible spinal injuries was rescued from the mountain with the assistance of the Alta Ski Patrol and Unified Fire Authority. He was transported to a local hospital via ambulance.
- **October 25<sup>th</sup> 10:25 AM-** Another citation was issued for a prohibited dog in the Albion area.
- **October 26<sup>th</sup> 10:07 AM-** A juvenile with possible head injuries was flown to the University of Utah Medical Center via an Air-Med Helicopter after a skiing accident.
- **October 31<sup>st</sup> 8:06 AM-** The Marshal's Office assisted a Sheriff's Deputy in serving an arrest warrant following a traffic stop in the lower canyon.
- **November 5<sup>th</sup> 1:52 PM-** The Marshal's Office was contacted by a resident who reported they had become an unwitting participant in an internet fraud scheme involving cashing of forged travelers checks. Information has been shared with the Identity Theft Task Force and Federal agencies as the source of the scheme appears to be overseas. A quantity of checks has been seized by our office.
