

Marshal's Report
August 10th - September 14th
2006

August 19, 2006 5:30 pm The Alta deputy escorted a 56 year old male, complaining that he was not feeling well to the UFA station 13 for an assessment of his condition. At 6:58 pm the deputy responded to the Snowbird Center to assist UFA with an apparent drug overdose. The 26 year old female patient was transported to hospital by ambulance.

August 21, 2006 11:54 am deputy found, recovered and returned the Supreme Ski Lift sign to the Alta Ski Lift Company

August 24, 2006 1:24 pm the deputy investigated an assault complaint involving two males. The conflict originated the previous night at the Snowbird Tram Club.

August 26, 2006 9:37 am Alta Dispatch received a call from a local resident on the Albion Summer Road. He reported smoke and flames coming from the exterior of a neighboring home. Alta Marshal's and UFA responded and quickly extinguished the fire. The origin of the fire was faulty electrical heat tape, which leads to the roof.

August 30, 2006 Deputy investigated a hit and run crash that occurred in the Albion Basin.

September 1, 2006 10:56 am the deputy investigated a crash involving an unattended vehicle that rolled off the south side of the road towards the Alta Lodge. The fortunate aspect of this incident is that the car was stopped short of hitting the lodge when it impacted a power pole. The power was knocked out, and later restored after the vehicle was recovered by a tow truck.

September 4, 2006 1:35 pm the deputy discovered a smoldering, illegal campfire in a group of trees near the Catherin's Pass trail. The fire required water and shoveling to put it out. 2:29 pm the deputy assisted a fatigued hiker by giving him and his son a ride to his vehicle that was located at the Snowbird resort.

September 7, 2006 8:40 pm the deputy was dispatched to assist with a two car crash, located mid-canyon near Tanners Flat. Although one car rolled a couple times, no serious injuries were reported.

September 9, 2006 4:00 pm The Marshal's Office assisted with the annual Peruvian Lodge, Down Hill Dash. 7:01 the deputy was dispatched to the Snowbird resort to assist with an unattended vehicle that rolled off the parking area and down the bank at entry 3.

September 11, 2006 10:00 am while on patrol in the Albion Basin the deputy on duty noticed a young group of kids at the Catherine's Pass trail head. Wondering why they weren't in school he stopped by for a chat. After conducting some interviews and contacting their schools, the kids' stories didn't pan out. They were sent back to school to meet with their school officers that were awaiting their arrival.

September 12, 2006 Dispatch took a report from a woman who had lost camera. 7:12 pm the deputy responded to a noise complaint at a construction site on the Blackjack Road. The workers were advised of the ordinance limiting construction activities from 6:30 am to 6:30 pm.

September 13, 2006 The Marshal's Office assisted the residents living along the Blackjack Road with an attempt to get the construction trucks and ATV's that pass through the residential area in route to the new snowbird lift to kindly drive slow.
