

MARSHAL'S REPORT
August 11th – September 8th, 2011

Misc Duties:

August 11th, 12:00 pm- Hikers discovered a baby moose that had somehow fallen into an open snowmaking system manhole in the Sunnyside area. The Marshal's Office, Alta Ski Lifts Company, Unified Fire Authority, and Division of Natural Resources all responded. The young moose was removed from the hole and reunited uninjured with its mother who was also in the area monitoring the rescue.

August 17- Residents were notified of a power outage that had the potential to last through the night. Fortunately, power was restored earlier than expected.

August 18th, 11:19 am- A search for a missing geology student was conducted in Albion Basin. The missing party was located and reunited with her group.

August 26th, 12:37 am- A medical response was made to one of the lodges for a person having difficulty breathing. The person was transported via private vehicle to a lower elevation.

August 27th, 2:54 pm- The Marshal's and Fire Department responded to a hiker injured by a rock fall in Albion Basin. The patient was treated for minor injuries and released.

August 28th, 1:17 am- Heavy rainfall resulted in a mudslide in the mid-canyon that temporarily closed the canyon highway.

September 2nd, 11:30 am- **The Marshal's Office assisted at the scene of a traffic accident in the lower canyon.**

September 3rd, 11:46 am- **The victim of a bicycle accident at the beginning of the Albion Summer Road was flown by medical helicopter to a local hospital in serious condition. Later in the day, a person was cited for animal cruelty for leaving a dog in a vehicle.**

September 5th, 2:06 pm- **The deputy on duty assisted the Unified Police and Fire Departments with a person having a seizure in the lower canyon. At 5:00 pm, the deputy assisted a lost juvenile in locating their parents in Albion Basin.**
